Bar Harbor, Maine – Children in Downeast Maine from Gouldsboro to Machias will continue to benefit from in-school, after-school, and summer enrichment programs thanks to a \$1 million gift from the Harold Alfond® Foundation. As a part of a challenge from an anonymous foundation, the gift will be matched dollar for dollar, resulting in \$2 million for EdGE.

EdGE is specifically designed to encourage youth to stay engaged in school, aspire toward and attain higher levels of achievement, and develop personal skills that enable them to achieve success in school and beyond. Currently, EdGE serves over 700 children in 17 communities throughout Washington County.
